NARRATIVE

On 03172010 at 0139 hours, I was on patrol and traveling north on Cloverhurst Avenue adjacent to People's Park when I observed a white male on a skateboard traveling south on Cloverhurst Avenue. The individual was in front of a car that was also traveling south on Cloverhurst Avenue and appeared to be cutting across that car's path of travel. The individual then crossed into my lane of travel in front of my patrol vehicle. At this time I activated my emergency lights and initiated a pedestrian stop on the individual.

I made contact with the pedestrian (Everbusch, Alexander H. - GA OLN: 053451351). I explained why I had stopped him and asked him for his driver's license. He stated that he didn't want any problems and provided me with his license. Everbusch was breathing heavily as I spoke with him and I could detect the strong odor commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. Everbusch stated that he had been at a friend's apartment on Finley Street and had been returning to his residence in Creswell Hall. Everbusch stated that he had a few beers earlier in the evening. A GCIC check of Everbusch's OLN confirmed him to be under the age of 21.

At this time, I placed Everbusch under arrest for Pedestrian Under the Influence (O.C.G.A. 40-6-95 m - Citation No: 020871) and Underage Possession of Alcohol (O.C.G.A. 3-3-23 m - Citation No: 020872). The offender was then placed in double-locked handcuffs behind his back and searched incident to arrest.

Prior to beginning my search, I asked the offender if he had any items on his person that might cut me, poke me or stick me. He stated that he did not. I then asked the offender if he had any contraband on his person that I needed to know about. He then lifted his left leg and stated, "Some weed." A search of the offender's person revealed a brownie which he stated had marijuana in it located in his left side cargo pocket of his shorts. A prescription pill bottle was also found with marijuana in his right side cargo pocket of his shorts. The offender was then charged with Possession of Marijuana - Less Than 1 Oz. (O.C.G.A 16-13-30 m - Citation No: 020873). Photographs of the items were taken. The items were later placed into Evidence Locker 005.

The offender was then transported to the Clarke County Jail. At the jail, the offender signed and was then provided with copies of his citations. The offender and his belongings were then turned over to jail personnel.
