Notes/Narratives

NARRATIVE

According to victims Hutson Vann and Meghan Vann, on 03-28-2010 at 0204 hours, they called for an A&A Taxi driver by the driver's personal cellphone# 706-351-9833 for a taxi ride home. The driver, whose name is unknown, did not answer, but the two victims saw the driver and were accepted as fares in front of the Mellow Mushroom. Both victims state they have had the driver previously, and he had been very nice, which is why they had his personal cellphone number. Both victims state that the driver picked up three intoxicated white males downtown, then stopped to pick up four black males carrying bratwursts in front of The Grill. The taxi driver stated "That's my homeboy Derek", indicating one of the black males, all of whom were UGA football players, according to victim Hutson Vann.

Victim Hutson Vann states that as the four black males were entering the van, he remarked that the brats smelled good, and asked how much they were. Both victims state that the black males sat in the seat behind them, and one stated "Shut up you stupid white racist fuck", and Mr. Vann stated that he had not made any racist remarks, and one of the four black males slapped or punched him in the back of the head, causing his head to go forward. When Mr. Vann complained and stated there was no reason for acting that way, the black males began telling him to shut up again, and began cursing him. One of the suspects clenched his fists and looked angrily at Mr. Vann, and told him to turn around if he wanted to live. When Mr. Vann turned to face forward, he put his arm around his wife, and one of the males slapped or punched him in the back of the head again. ~~Victim Meghan Vann told the males to stop, and one slapped or punched her in the back of the head.~~ Victims state that their friend Brent Borganmeister was also seated in the van and told them that the one doing the hitting was the male sitting directly behind Hutson Vann. Both victims state that the black males began speaking ugly to Mrs Vann, stating "Do you want some black dick?" several times, and stating "We'll put you on a swing, gang bang you".

Both victims state they were terrified and stayed hunkered down in their seats until the four suspects were dropped off at East Campus Village. Victims state they were dropped off at their residence at approximately 0300 hours, and state that the taxi driver claimed to not know any of the suspect's identities.
