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NARRATIVE

On 022710 at 0240 hours I was acting as Officer Rocklein's backup on a traffic stop at River's Crossing. During the traffic stop I saw a Much Love Taxi cab pull into the River's Crossing Parking Lot. I heard the taxi driver, Brenda Elaine Scott, yelling at the passengers inside of the vehicle. I made contact with Scott who stated that her front seat passenger was urinating in the taxi. She further stated that his penis was showing. I then made contact with the front seat passenger, later identified as Roger Barry Leithead III. Leithead was slumped over with his penis out of his pants, and he was urinating inside of the taxi. Leithead was unresponsive to my questions, and I noticed a strong odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages coming from his breath and person. Due to Leithead's state of intoxication, and the fact that the other passengers were only slightly familiar with him, I reached into his jacket pocket and obtained his driver's license from his wallet in order to determine his identity. A GCIC check of Leithead's identifying information revealed that he was under the age of 21. National EMS arrived on scene at 0256 hours and transported Leithead to Athens Regional Medical Center for further treatment.

While I was dealing with Leithead the three backseat passengers of the taxi (later identified as Daniel Wayne Skelton, Connor Thomas Lynch, and Kyle Wesley Pritchett) exited the vehicle. I ordered Skelton, Lynch, and Pritchett to stand on the sidewalk while I dealt with Leithead. Lynch and Pritchett urinated on themselves while they were standing outside of the taxi. I interviewed Skelton, Lynch, and Pritchett individually to find out how they knew Leithead and to determine their involvement in this incident. While speaking to Skelton I noticed a moderate odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages coming from his breath. His eyes were bloodshot and glassy. Skelton was being cooperative, and he stated that he had consumed one alcoholic beverage. A GCIC check of Skelton's identifying information revealed that he was under the age of 21. At 0308 hours I placed Skelton under arrest for underage possession of alcohol. He was placed into double-locked handcuffs and searched incident to arrest. During the search of his person a valid Georgia Driver's License issued to Thomas Gregory Bennett [REDACTED] with a date of birth that showed him to be over the age of 21 was found in Skelton's wallet. Skelton was later read the Miranda Warning by Corporal Pennington and subsequently admitted that he used the driver's license issued to Bennett to illegally obtain alcohol from bars downtown. Skelton was additionally charged with possession of a fraudulent identification. The fraudulent identification was taken into evidence and placed into locker number 015 to be held for trial. Skelton was seatbelted in the backseat of Corporal Pennington's patrol vehicle and transported to the Clarke County Jail.

While speaking to Lynch I noticed a strong odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages coming from his breath. Lynch kept yelling at Leithead, who was still seated in the taxi, that he was concerned for his well-being. Lynch continued yelling towards the taxi although I told him to remain silent several times. A GCIC check of Lynch's identifying information revealed that he was under the age of 21. At 0305 hours Lynch was placed under arrest for underage possession of alcohol. He was placed into double-locked handcuffs and seated in the backseat of my patrol vehicle. Due to the fact that I was dealing with the three other passengers at the time, I requested that Officer Rocklein watch Lynch because I did not have time to search him before placing him in my patrol vehicle. By this time Corporal Pennington had arrived on scene and placed Pritchett into investigative detention due to the fact that Pritchett kept putting his hands in his pockets after repeatedly being asked to keep them visible. At this time Corporal Pennington heard what sounded like a struggle between Officer Rocklein and Lynch. Corporal Pennington made contact with Officer Rocklein and Lynch and determined that Lynch had not been searched incident to arrest. Officer Rocklein advised Corporal Pennington that Lynch was not complying with his orders. Corporal Pennington noticed that Lynch had his cell phone in his hand, and he was stating that he wanted to call his parents. Corporal Pennington told Lynch that he needed to be searched and ordered him to exit the vehicle to which Lynch replied, "No, not until I call my parents." Officer Rocklein ordered Lynch to take his feet out of the vehicle and Lynch again refused to comply. Corporal Pennington and Officer Rocklein were eventually able to get Lynch out of the vehicle. Corporal Pennington again ordered Lynch to give him the phone and Lynch refused. Corporal Pennington then advised Lynch that if he did not release the phone and continued to physically resist he would be charged with obstruction. Corporal Pennington once again tried to obtain the phone but Lynch maintained his grip on the phone. Corporal Pennington was eventually able to obtain the phone and Officer Rocklein searched Lynch incident to arrest. During the search Corporal Pennington stated that Lynch continued to be verbally combative with Officer Rocklein. Lynch was later seatbelted in the backseat of my patrol vehicle and transported to the Clarke County Jail.

While speaking to Pritchett I noticed a strong odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages coming from his breath. A GCIC check of Pritchett's information revealed that he was 21 years old. Pritchett was subsequently released from the scene.

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Notes/Narratives

Scott stated that Leithead owed her \$5.00 for the taxi fare and an additional \$100.00 fee for urinating in the taxi. Neither of these fees were collected on scene by Scott.

While at the jail, Lynch was read the Miranda Warning and stated that he wished to speak to a lawyer. I advised him that I had no further questions at that time. Skelton, who had previously been advised of his rights, was asked to provide a breath sample to which he declined. Skelton was released into the custody of deputies along with his belongings which included an Iphone, a wallet, \$26.00 cash, and a Blackberry that he stated belonged to Leithead. Lynch was also released into the custody of deputies along with his belongings which included a wallet, cell phone, and two sets of keys.

NARRATIVE

On this date I first made contact with Mr. Jorvy Mammen when I served him with a criminal trespass warning at 171 College AVE. (see CRN 01-10-02-1768) prior to being barred from the property Mr. Mammen had already started being loud and belligerent towards not only me but also the employees of The Grill. After he was informed of being barred from the property I told Mr. Mammen that he needed to leave, I also informed him that while he was in the process of leaving he did not need to yell or even say anything to the employees. I then went inside the business to get the managers information for my criminal trespass warning report, I was in there approximately 5 minutes when I came back out Mr. Mammen was on the corner of Clayton ST. and College AVE. I witnessed Mr. Mammen yell at three employees leaving The Grill to go home "YOUR LOSS! YOU WONT BE GETTING ANY INCOME FROM ME FOR THE NEXT TWO YEARS!"

It was at this point that I decided to place Mr. Mammen under arrest for public intoxication. He told me over and over that he was not drunk and wanted to take a breath test to prove it, I told him that was not an option. I then allowed him to blow a sample into my roadside alco-synsor. The alco-synsor gave a reading of 0.22 BAC.

Mr. Mammen was transported to the CCSO jail.
