NARRATIVE

On Friday the 9th of April 2010 at 1246hrs, I was dispatched to 440 South Milledge. There I was to meet a female that had been a victim of a theft by sudden snatch. There I met the Victim, Bridget. She told me that this morning around 0130hrs, she was leaving a fraternity at Broad at Lumpkin. She was walking home. She was on the side walk on the west side of Milledge. She said she was in the area of Waddell. She said that a black male approached her from the right. He came to her and grabbed her purse. She said that he did not say anything to her. He just came up and snatched her purse. She had the strap of the purse on her left shoulder around her neck. The purse was resting on her right hip. I asked has the cards been cancelled. She said yes. She had called her father. I asked did she have her phone. She said yes. Then, she said that she had loaned it out. I asked why not call the Police. She said that there was nothing we could have done. I gave her the case number. There is no further at this time.
