Notes/Narratives

NARRATIVE

At 0145hrs I was dispatched to the The Station Apts in reference to a female that had urinated in a Top Dawg taxi and was refusing to pay the \$90.00 for urinating in the seat. When I arrived I contacted the driver and he pointed to the front seat which appeared to be very wet and told the offender had urinated in the seat. He said she paid for the fare but was refusing to pay the additional charge urinating in seat.

I then spoke to the offender who was noticeably intoxicated. She had trouble keeping her balance, smelled strongly of an alcoholic beverage and had blood shot eyes. When I first started speaking with her she was on a cell phone. I asked her to put the cell phone down so I could speak to her. After asking her several times she then tried to hand me her phone for me to talk to the person she was speaking with on the phone. I told her I did not need to speak to the person and she finally put the phone away. I asked her about urinating the cab and she said she did not know that she was really drunk. When I asked her how old she was she said she was twenty. She then told me, "For the record he is full of shit." I asked her to turn around so I could see if the back of her dress was wet since she did not know or denied urinating in the cab. When she turned around her dress was wet in the area you would expect it to be if someone urinated while in a seat. I then asked for ID and she told me she did not want to give it to me. I had to ask close to a dozen times for her ID. She eventually agreed to pay the \$90.00 to the cab driver. While looking in her wallet for a credit card a Notre Dame student ID card and a Tennessee driver's license issued to: BUGNITZ, MARIE CATHERINE - [REDACTED] 86 - were found. When I asked her about the card with the name Marie she at first told me that she was Marie and then later told me her correct name once her ID was found. While at the scene she told me several times she just wanted to go home and pointed to an apartment to her right. She later again stated she wanted to go home but pointed an apartment to her left on the other side of the parking lot. The offender was arrested, transported and released to CCSO Jail.
